I have exhibited and bred Labrador Retrievers under the "Guntreva" prefix for 35 years. During this time dogs that I have bred and owned have been very successful in the All Breeds and Specialty rings. I have also owned/exhibited Golden Retrievers, American Cocker Spaniels, Lhasa Apso's and a Welsh Corgi Pembroke.

In 1997 I gained my judging licence for Gundogs and in 2010 gained ANKC All Breeds status. My judging appointments have taken me to most states in Australia, both North & South Islands of New Zealand and also South Africa.

I have served on many committees over the years and am currently Chairperson of Dogs Old Library & Archives Sub Committee and President of the Labrador Retriever Club of Qld. For a number of years I held the position of Judges Training Co-Ordinator for the Gundog Group with Dogs Qld., until work commitments led to my having to step down from this position.

I entered the dog world in 1976 showing Old English Sheepdogs and Collies. Since this time my main focus has been Tibetan Terriers and Cavalier King Charles Spaniels (all four colors).

I also breed Miniature Pinschers under the "Khanrae" prefix. Champions carrying this prefix number in excess of 60 including many All Breed and Specialty Best In Show winners.

Other breeds include the Pembroke Corgi, Shar Pei, Pekingese, Boxer, Pug, Afghan, OES, English Setter, Pointer, Cairn Terrier and I also handled the first Black Smooth Griffon Bruxellois in the Southern Hemisphere to gain a championship title.

I started judging in 1994 and am licensed to judge the Toy, Gundog, Hound, Working Dog, and Non Sporting groups and Junior Showmanship at Championship level, and the Terrier Group, Utility Group & Best In Show at Open show level. I have judged in England, Sweden, South Africa, New Zealand, & Australia.

I commenced showing dogs in 1963 with Beagles, changing to English Cocker Spaniels and also handled Australian Terriers. I commenced judging in 1969 and became a Malaysian All Breeds Judge in 1978 and an Australian All Breeds Judge in 1988 and has been a member of many management committees for Dog Clubs and controlling State Associations.
